

## Shu-mei Shih

is the Irving and Jean Stone Chair in Humanities at UCLA, where she is Professor of Comparative Literature, Asian Languages and Cultures, and Asian American Studies. She also holds an honorary chair professorship at National Taiwan Normal University.



Her influential book *Visuality and Identity: Sinophone Articulations across the Pacific* (2007) has been credited with inaugurating the field of Sinophone Studies and has gone through several printings. For the field, she has coedited *Sinophone Studies: A Critical Reader* (2013) and *Sinophone Studies across Disciplines* (2024), and authored *Against Diaspora: Discourses on Sinophone Studies* (2017). Her forthcoming book is *Sinophone Divergences: Empire, Race, Theory.* Beyond Sinophone Studies, her research interests include comparative literature, Taiwan studies, modernism, critical race studies, and critical theory.
